10.30 **Annie's Lane Winery**

Now owned by the Fosters Group, Annie's Lane was launched in 1996 and is located at the heritage listed Quelltaler winery in South Australia's Watervale

DAY 2

10am Depart for **Bungaree Station**

Bungaree Station is a beautiful rural property Established in 1841, is not a museum, but rather a living record of rural Australia since 1841. While taking the guided tour you will get to a wonderful insight into 19th century station life. You will get to see St Michael's Church & Cemetery, the Homestead Gardens, the Woolshed and the Station Store, and see displays of old tools and equipment, carts and vintage vehicles.

Then stop for a 2 course light lunch at the Station
